Prof. František Duchoň works as a professor at the Institute of Robotics and Cybernetics FEI STU. Currently, he is also the president of the National Centre of Robotics. He is the author of more than 200 publications focused on robotics and related scientific fields, for which he has more than 1000 citations. He successfully supervised over 100 defended student theses, including three doctoral theses. In 2015, he and his team were awarded the Best Innovator's Approach to Technology Transfer. He worked almost 10 times as an evaluator of European projects under the European Commission. He was or is the researcher in 32 research projects in grant schemes, 20 times in the position of the principal investigator or principal investigator of a partner. In 2020, he was a finalist in the KUKA Innovation Awards with his team and the SAHARRA project. He is also the author or co-author of more than 10 utility models or patents.
