She has been active in the artificial intelligence area for a long time. She has authored/co-authored more than 70 publications in scientific journals and conferences. She has participated in more than 25 national and international research projects and has coordinated several of them.

She worked for 4 years as a research fellow at the University of Stuttgart. From 2011 to 2019, she was a vice-dean of FIIT STU. She was a vice-chairman of the Scientific Board of the Slovak Research Centre for Artificial Intelligence. She is a member of IFIP TC8 as a national representative of Slovakia.
