Miriam Lexmann (KDH) is a Member of the European Parliament for Slovakia and sits within the Group of the European People's Party (EPP). The core focus of her work is defending freedom, democracy and human dignity both within the European Union and abroad. She is a member of the EP's Foreign Affairs Committee (AFET), sub-Committee on Security and Defence (SEDE), Committee on Employment and Social Affairs (EMPL), Delegation for Relations with Belarus and Delegation to the Euronest Parliamentary Assembly.

Miriam is one of the founding members and co-chairs of the Inter-Parliamentary Alliance on China (IPAC) as well as the European Parliament's informal Hong Kong Watch Group and United For Ukraine Working Group. Miriam is also a board member of the Tunega, Púčik and Tesár Foundation.

Prior to being elected as a Member of the European Parliament, Miriam worked in international democracy support as the International Republican Institute EU Office Director and in diplomacy as Permanent Representative of the Slovak National Council to the EU. She also worked in advisory roles within the European Parliament and the Council of Europe.
